- 1. The Government of Uganda represented by National Forestry Authority has received financing from the World Bank towards the cost of Investing in Forests and Protected Areas for Climate Smart Development Project and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for Design, supply and construction of 300m board walks, bird hides, jetty docking area, a picnic site and eco gates.

It is expected that the Request for Proposals will be made in March, 2025.
- 3. Initial Selection will be conducted through the procedures as specified in the World Bank's Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers" July 2016 updated September 2023 ("Procurement Regulations") and is open to all eligible Applicants as defined in the Procurement Regulations.
- 4. Interested eligible Applicants may obtain further information from the National Forestry Authority, Procurement and Disposal Unit and inspect the initial selection documents during office hours from 08: 30a.m to 05: 00p.m (Monday to Friday) at the address indicated in No. 8.
